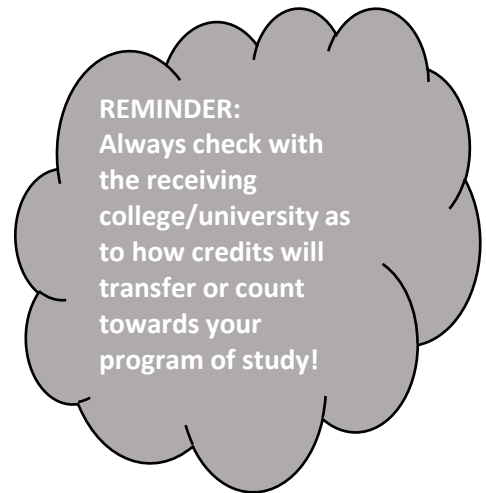


# Michigan Transfer Agreement/Dual Enrollment Worksheet
